


#### 2012 Where to get them

That is a 3/4" pipe thread








Better option

- \* Took up to 20-30 minutes






#### Added a pump




#### 2013 Added a timer






- \* No pictures

- \* Ran branch of hose to second floor




- \* Found out garden hoses don't hold up to continuous pressure.

- \*:(






- \* Switched to proper water lines


- \* Added waterline to front of the house

- \* Bought valves and wire

#### Why?

- \* Use rainwater
- \* Tax break
- \* Less effort
- \* More regular watering
- \* Weather-responsive watering
- \* Different watering for each zone
- \* Fun to do
- \* Makes my wife's life easier

\* Spend money on a pump! It was a game changer.



- \* Get valves with pressure regulators
  - \* They will be bigger but you can get a cheap adapter





\* Adjustable bubbler emitters

\* \$20 on Amazon for 50 if you can wait





\* OpenSprinkler works perfectly and the iOS App is useful



#### What not to do

- \* Use garden hose for constant pressure
- \* Use valves without pressure regulators
  - \* Spending more on a bigger valve with adapter is much cheaper than parts to add a manual valve
- \* Standardize, I spent way too much on adapters
- \* Should have run 7 strand wires

#### What to watch out for

- \* Leaks are big problem on a pressurized system
- \* Pon't forget to address mosquitoes
  - \* Add screening to air holes
