How many Al interfaces are there?

- WebUI:
 - Open WebUI (Formerly Ollama WebUI)
 - LibreChat
 - Various proprietary ones (ChatGPT, Claude, Google Gemini, etc)
- Terminal-based:
 - fabric
 - sigoden / aichat (https://github.com/sigoden/aichat)

Why Open-source WebUI?

- 1. **All-in-one solution**: Unified chat, prompt and file management.
- 2. Less downtime: APIs have less downtime than the chat service.
- 3. Portability: Don't like a specific company/chat service? Bring your chat logs with you and move!
- 4. **Less censorship**: Specific names are censored in some online chat services, but not while using their APIs.
- 5. **Local models**: You are able to run local models, even generate content offline.
- 6. **Less data collection**: Even without using local models, company collect less data from you when you use their APIs.

Why Open WebUI?

- Customizable: There are so many parameters associated with a single model. Adjust them accordingly.
- 2. Convenient: Tools, prompts, "/, @ and #" shorthands.
- Well-designed file management: Files uploaded as "knowledge", all the files are in one place, categorized as "collections".
- 4. Access to every single model existed: Write your own functions and build your own pipelines.
- 5. **Feature-rich**: I'm going to talk about this later.
- Settings: They are stored in the database, not as cookies.
